Daniel Beal is an Ukrainian-American pianist, who has been a guest artist with two orchestras, and participates successfully in local, regional and international competitions, becoming a national finalist in the 2022 MTNA Piano Performance Competition. He has won state MTNA competitions two years in a row, and won the SMTA State Recitalist Competition four years in a row.

He has numerous 1st place honors in the Spokane Piano Competition. Daniel has also won several international competitions, including Platinum Prize at the 2023 Global Classical Music Championship (European Classical Music Awards), Platinum Prize and Excellent Technique Special Award at the 2023 Saint-Saëns International Music Competition and First Place at the 2023 Winter Edition King's Peak International Music Competition. He has been awarded over two dozen gold medals at Musicfest Northwest held at Gonzaga University, including gold medals for concertos at ages nine, ten and fifteen. He is grateful to his long-term instructor Barbara Miller for her support. Daniel volunteers at retirement centers and the public library, and has been a performer and presenter on Spokane Public Radio several times. He believes classical music is an irreplaceable part of our culture today.

Mark Lev Krajnc was born in June 2007. He started learning the violin at the age of 5 and a half. For the first five years of junior music school, he was taught by Barbara Kolbl (formerly Fanedl), a violin professor. He completed the 6th-8th grade of the lower music level at the Fran Korun Koželjski Music School in Velenje, in the class of Danica Koren, violin professor.

He passed the entrance exam prematurely and continues his musical education in the 2023/24 school year at the Velenje Art High School - 3nd year of parallel education, majoring in violin - in the class of Professor Danica Koren and at the same time 2st year III. Gymnasium Maribor. He perfects his knowledge at seminars with prof. Miran and Prof. Barbara Kolbl, prof. Anna Morgoulets, Žiga Brank and others. He participated in nine Summer Music Schools of Professor Danica Koren Neuvirt in Zaton. At the age of 10, he performed as a soloist at five concerts accompanied by the chamber orchestra of the Danica Koren Neuvirt Summer Music School in Zaton near Zadar and received a wave of good reviews. Mark Lev is the recipient of two Korun awards (school year 2019/20 and 2020/21), which are awarded by the Fran Korun Koželjski Music School to the most successful students of the junior music school. Mark Lev enjoys music very much. He cannot imagine life without a violin and wants to continue the path of a successful solo violinist.

Eva Boguniová and continued her studies of piano performance and piano pedagogy at Janácek Academy of Music in Brno, where she became a student of prof. Alena Vlasáková. In 2012 and 2013 was awarded a full scholarship for The Piano Institute summer programme in Kent, USA. Two years later she received scholarship for The Summer Sonata programme at Cleveland Institute of Music, USA, In summer 2016 she recieved scholarship again and took part in Montecito International Music Festival in California. where she studied in the class of prof. Sandra Shapiro. Anna-Sofie took part in many piano competitions where she was awarded prominent prizes. As a soloist, she has also performed with orchestras (Brno Philharmonic Orchestra, Hradec Králové Philharmony, Vác Philharmony or Moravian Philharmonic Orchestra). 
